REVISION OF PSA APPLICATION FEES AND PASS VALIDITY

PSA is committed to maintaining a **safe and secure port environment**.

To strengthen access control and prevent misuse of passes and vehicle permits, PSA regularly reviews its access management rules.

With increasing security requirements, selected application fees and pass validity periods will be revised with effect from **1st July 2026**.

These changes support:

- Proper control and tracking of passes
- Prevention of unauthorised access
- Responsible use of access privileges

Revised Application Fees (Effective 1st July 2026)

Application Type	New Charges	With 9% GST
New Application (1 Year Validity)	\$40	\$43.60
Renewal Application (1 Year Validity)	\$30	\$32.70
Short-Term Car Entry Permit	\$3 per day	\$3 x day(s) x 1.09
Lost Pass Replacement	\$100	Not applicable

Note: The replacement charge aims to deter loss and misuse, which poses security risks to port operations.

Revision to Pass Validity Duration

To further strengthen access control and prevent prolonged issuance of temporary passes, the maximum validity period for short-term entry passes will be revised with effect from **1st July 2026** as follows:

Application Type	New Changes
Short-Term Entry Pass	1 to 7 days
