SPEED LIMITER REQUIREMENT FOR LORRIES FROM 1 JANUARY 2026

- 1 In line with road safety enhancement measures, the Traffic Police (TP) will require lorries with a Maximum Laden Weight (MLW) of between 3,501kg and 12,000kg (inclusive) to be installed with speed limiters, which will ensure that these lorries do not go beyond the speed limit of 60km/h.
- 2 The enforcement of this requirement is being implemented progressively from 1 January 2026, in accordance with TP's phased rollout: -

Category	MLW (kg)	Date from which requirements applies
Older models of lorries (Registered before 1 January 2018)	5,001 – 12,000	1 January 2026
	3,501 – 5,000`	1 July 2026
Newer models of lorries (Registered on or after 1 January 2018)	5,001 – 12,000	1 January 2027
	3,501 – 5,000	1 July 2027

- 3 PSA has commenced checks on the speed limiter compliance label for lorries entering PSA's Restricted Areas to ensure compliance with prevailing statutory requirements.
- 4 With immediate effect, PSA will deny access to all lorries that do not comply with statutory requirements.
- 5 Companies and lorry owners are reminded to take note of the applicable compliance deadlines and to ensure that all affected vehicles meet the statutory speed limiter requirements before seeking entry into PSA's premises.
